Kakishibu: Persimmon-dyed products

Kakishibu House Mimasu's kakishibu products are all natural, made from raw cotton and persimmon fruit. The result is a product that is cool and refreshing in the summer, yet warm and comforting in autumn and winter.

Tennogaki persimmon fruits are used to make the soaking mixture as they have a large number of tannins. This juice is aged for over three years, then has granulated persimmon tannin agent especially developed by Mimasu added to the mixture, before being used to dye each kakishibu piece by hand.

Care instructions - it's easy!

- Washing by hand with some water is usually sufficient to keep these pieces clean. Thanks to their anti-static qualities, dust and pollen doesn't build up very much.
- Please wash separately to avoid the natural dye and color bleeding into other fabrics.
- If using detergent, please choose a neutral detergent.
- After washing, shape the fabric to its original shape before hanging out to dry (sunlight or shade both OK).
- Avoid soaking the product in water for extended periods of time.
